Arrival & Dismissal



School starts 7:30AM (Scholars may NOT be dropped any earlier as there is no one to receive them in the building). Breakfast runs from 7:30A – 8:00A. Scholars are tardy as of 8:20A. Dismissal begins at 3:30 per the guidelines below.

Parent drop off /pick up

Parents are to enter the parking lot on E. 146th street and follow the orange cones around to the drop off/pick up location. Scholars must be in FULL UNIFORM (as indicated below & on school website).

Early pick up

EVERY MINUTE MATTERS at LEP and scholar's days are planned to the minute to ensure that they get the most out of time spent in the classroom. Parents/guardians must contact the school prior to 1:00P to ensure proper notification/preparation for early release.

Walkers/RTA riders

Enter through the main double doors.

Yellow Bus/Daycare vans

Scholars are released to the buses/vans in a timely manner. Any delays will be communicated to families via the school messenger. If you will be in need of transportation and need to apply for it, please contact the main office and speak to Mrs. Mack.

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Uniform

At Lake Erie Preparatory school (LEP), we believe the path to success starts with how we first see ourselves. We are COMMITTED TO EXCELLENCE; our uniform policy is stated below:

Male Dress Code

- **BLACK Pants** – No Jeans/Leggings/Joggers/Shorts
- **Black Belt ONLY**
- **Ties** – School issued ties must be worn at all times. Ties will be kept at school.
- **White button-down shirt**- Long or Short (**WE DO NOT WEAR POLO STYLE SHIRTS**)
 - Under shirt – solid dark color only (no bright colors or logo t-shirts). T-shirt should match shirt length.
- **BLAZERS** – Will be kept at school. The blazer must be worn at all times. (6-8)
- **SWEATER VESTS** – NAVY BLUE ONLY (Grades K-5). The school has a monogrammed vest available for purchase. The vest must always be worn.
- **SOCKS** – Solid black or white must be worn.
- **SHOES** – BLACK DRESS SHOES ONLY. EXCEPTIONS: SPERRY'S OR ALL BLACK VANS. NO GYM SHOES OR BOOTS can be worn during school outside of PE class.
- **JEWELRY** – Scholars are permitted to wear studs for earrings (one per ear) and wristwatches are permitted; otherwise no other jewelry (including body piercing jewelry) of any kind can be shown or is permitted.



Female Dress Code

- **BLACK Pants** – No Jeans/Leggings/Joggers/Shorts (NO LEGGINGS/NO YOGA PANTS/NO JEGGINGS)
- **BLACK SKIRTS** – The black skirt must fall two inches below the knee. Girls must wear shorts under skirts on days designated for physical activity.
- **JUMPERS** – Girls in grades K-5 may wear a black uniform jumper with a simulated vest top attached to the skirt. Skirt length must be at the knees. A blue sweater vest does not need to be worn if a jumper is worn.
- **Black Belt ONLY**
- **Ties** – School issued ties must be worn at all times. Ties will be kept at school.
- **White button-down shirt**- Long or Short (**WE DO NOT WEAR POLO STYLE SHIRTS**)
 - Under shirt – solid dark color only (no bright colors or logo t-shirts). T-shirt should match shirt length.
- **BLAZERS** – Will be kept at school. The jacket must be worn at all times. (6-8)
- **SWEATER VESTS/CARDIGANS** – NAVY BLUE ONLY (Grades K-5). The school has a monogrammed vest available for purchase. The vest must always be worn.
- **SOCKS/TIGHTS** – Solid black or white must be worn. (NO LEGGINGS/NO YOGA PANTS/NO JEGGINGS)
- **SHOES** – BLACK DRESS SHOES ONLY. EXCEPTIONS: SPERRY'S OR ALL BLACK VANS. NO GYM SHOES OR BOOTS can be worn during school outside of PE class.
- **JEWELRY** - Conservative jewelry is permitted. Some necklaces of any material, bracelets, rings, earrings, nose rings, piercing and anklets may be prohibited. Earrings must be the size of a quarter or smaller. No tongue rings.

Consequences for failure to wear uniform include but are not limited to: Reminders letters (3x), conference with school administration, detention, suspension and/or potential removal from Lake Erie Preparatory school.

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COVID-19 Assessment

Please be reminded that all scholars and staff must continue to be screened for symptoms each day. Parents or guardians need to actively screen their households and scholars each day. If your child has developed symptoms, please contact the school. Temperatures screenings for scholars/staff will be conducted twice daily. If your scholar is deemed symptomatic you will be contacted to pick them up and follow the return protocols given to you by the school. Another communication will be coming regarding specific school mandates, guidance is subject to change as it is reviewed every couple weeks.
